COURSE DESCRIPTION:

With the ever increasing number of new drugs, substitute drugs, designer drugs, and non-traditional drugs being manufactured, imported and used by today's drug culture, law enforcement is faced with the challenges of keeping up with these emerging drug trends and new drugs of abuse. Many of these drugs, like MDMA and LSD Substitutes, DMT DXM, Kratom, and Salvia Divinorum, are not covered in the traditional drug training curriculum. Additionally, emerging trends in the club and party scene are not well known to law enforcement.

This course will provide the student with the knowledge to identify these drugs, recognize the symptomology, methods of ingestion, and paraphernalia associated with the use of these drugs, and discuss the legal aspects of dealing with persons in possession and/or under the influence of these drugs. This course will also discuss the current trends within the club and party scene.

INSTRUCTOR:

Troy Gielish is a Sergeant with the Irvine Police Department and has had years of experience working narcotics investigations and evaluating people under the influence. He has worked for both State and Federal agencies and is an Advanced Officer Training Instructor for agencies including: DEA, CNOA, OCSD, and CHP.
